We offer a wide range of activities to people who access our service both within the centre and in the local community.

Within the centre we have a working café, garden centre, pottery and print rooms all providing working experiences and community involvement for individuals who attend our centre

There are several Buildings on this site, new external signage has been provided to guide you to the correct building.

The Centre is used Mondays to Fridays on a daily basis, for the care of people with learning disabilities, to use the changing places toilet it is advised to phone ahead to check for availability or alternatively just call in.

## Equipment and layout

<b>Toilet Facility</b>
Room size –4000mm x 3800mm (13'1''ft x 12'ft 4'')
Height adjustable, free standing changing couch 1050mm Wide x 1200mm long with an additional 400mm back rest.
Fixed ceiling tracking hoist- 'H' system Tracking hoist covering the majority of the room. Covering approx – 2700mm x 3800mm (8' 8'' x 12'ft 4'')
Wash hand basin – An electrical rise and fall wash hand basin with mirror
Non-slip floor
Large waste disposal bin
Standard Bin Provided also.
Appropriate signage to use the facility
Centrally located toilet
A screen to allow disabled person and carer some privacy
Wide tear off roll to cover bench.

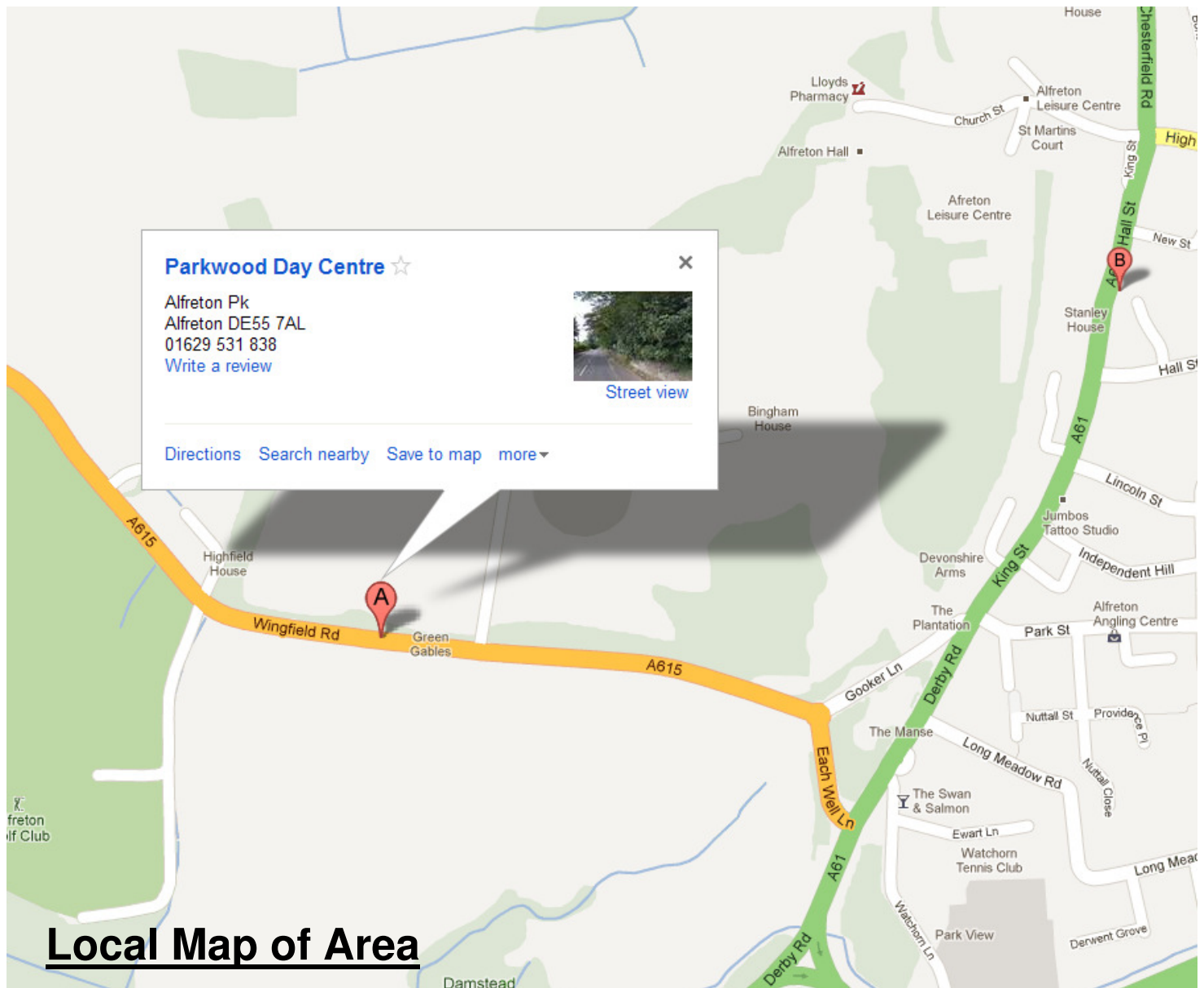


Photo two – shows the Wc and colour contrasting grab rails.
