Meeting point – Millers Dale Station Car Park for the Monsal Trail. The nearest post code is SK17 8SN . Accessible toilets available and a catering van which serves drinks and ice creams is on site every day

Joining us on this festive walk are friends of Cromford Canal, who are happy for walkers to use their narrowboat 'Birdswood' to complete part of the journey to or from the Lea Pumping Station just past High Peak Junction (1.2 miles). Unfortunately at present the boat isn't accessible for wheelchair users.
